### Bernie Keogh – The Red Umbrellas

The red umbrellas are a series of paintings depicting life: - love, joy and sadness; raising a family; loving; letting go; coping with emotional storms and the sunshine.

In fact you could say that whole exhibition is about love. The umbrellas depict life, and Galway the city of my birth is the place I love. I never tire of painting its winding streets, crooked houses and now – it's rooftops.

Bernie Keogh is the owner and tutor at the Lodge Studio, an 18<sup>th</sup> Century Gothic Gate Lodge that she lovingly restored over a eight year period. Her studio is situated in her gardens in a woodland setting, which is where she teaches her adult courses and tutors in the South of France on a regular basis.

Bernie has worked as an Interior Designer and Colour Consultant working in private homes, schools and churches. She designs personalised business cards, hotel brochures and Christmas cards for charity.

From 1972-93 Bernie taught art in many secondary schools in Galway. She was employed as the art teacher at St. Joseph's College, Galway for 6 years full-time and 10 years as a part-time teacher. She has also worked at St. Mary's College, St. Enda's College, Park College and Mervue National School, Galway. During this time she also illustrated examination papers for the Department of Education.

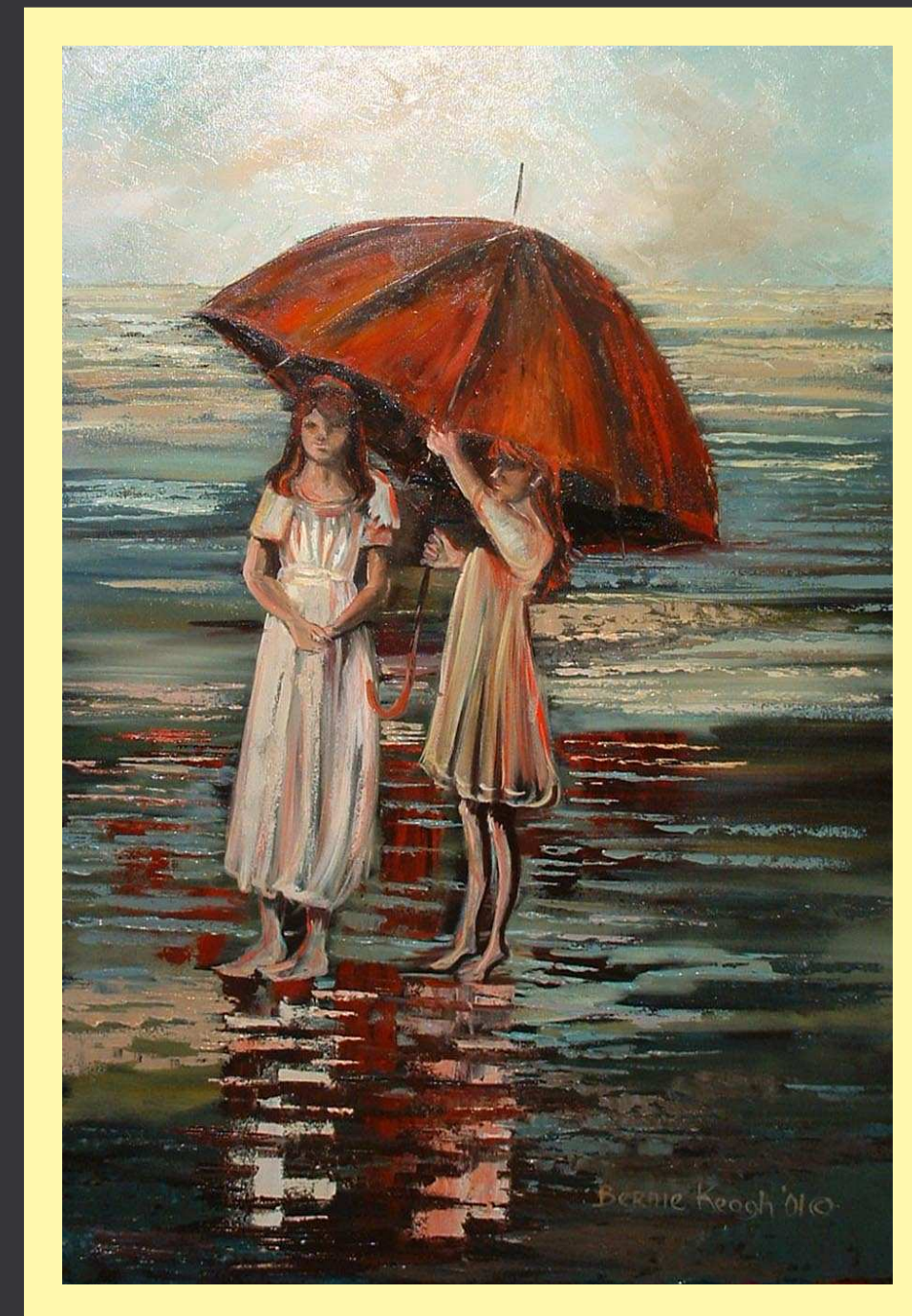
