Yassine Imejjat was born in Casablanca, Morocco in 1980.

Yassine's work is inspired from the modern fashion world driven by his earlier passion to become a designer. In Morocco however, to become a designer proved impossible as the opportunity to develop this career did not arise for him and choices were limited. After his job as a chef ended the desire to retrieve his interest in the arts continued on even though in what direction or style he wasn't sure.
